Right Turns – How to Avoid Accidents

One of the most common ways that garbage trucks are involved in accidents is making a right turn and hitting another vehicle or a pedestrian. The other vehicle may be attempting to pass on the right or making a right turn.

You can prevent accidents involving right turns by:

1. Checking your mirrors – especially the right side
2. Getting into the right lane well in advance of the turn
3. Using your turn signal and slowing down in advance of the turn
4. Driving close to the curb so another vehicle does not try to sneak in

In addition, make the turn without crossing into the center line of the road you are leaving or into the opposing traffic lanes of the street you are entering.

Be smart on the route – watch out for all hazards at all intersections!
